Public Input Sought on SDC

Members of the Social Development Commission's (SDC) Board of Commissioners are looking to hear from the public about how the agency is doing. Public hearings are scheduled that will be the first in an ongoing series hosted by elected commissioners of SDC.

SDC District 2 representative Virgie Wynn will host a public forum Wednesday, September 21 for district residents. The public meeting will start at 6 pm at Holy Redeemer Church at 3500 Mother Daniels Way, near the intersection of 35th and Hampton. SDC District 2 lies roughly between Hampton and Center Streets in the City of Milwaukee and runs west from the Milwaukee River to the boundary with the city of Wauwatosa.

SDC District 1 Commissioner Kristina McHenry will hold a public forum on Thursday, September 22 to hear from residents of her district. SDC's District 1 includes the City of Milwaukee north of Hampton Avenue and North Shore communities plus Brown Deer and Wauwatosa. The hearing will be held at the John C Cudahy YMCA at 9050 N. Swan Boulevard beginning at 6 pm.

SDC District 3 Commissioner Gail Winston has scheduled a public forum for district residents on Tuesday, October 4. That open meeting will be held at 6 pm at Urban Day School located at 1312 N. 27th Street. Commissioner Winston's district is bordered on the north by Center Street and on the south by Clybourne Avenue and on the east by N. 12th street running to 60th Street on the west.

Commissioners Wynn, McHenry and Winston are seeking input from residents of their districts on the needs of the community, how well SDC is doing is meeting those needs, and suggestions on how SDC or other entities should respond to those needs.
