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## Youth Feed Youth

A group of young people is making sure other youth don't go hungry this summer. The 14 young women and men are workers for the Social Development Commission (SDC) Summer Food Program.

The youth have been putting together meals that are served at 55 sites across the Milwaukee area during summer vacation months when thousands of youngsters are not able to access their school lunch program. The Summer Meals program is a collaboration of many agencies including SDC. The young workers at SDC have put together more than 80,000 meals so far this summer for the program that will continue for another week.

Staff from the SDC Food Program who worked with the youth on the Summer Meals program praised them for their dedication and efforts to provide the food that was needed so much. The youth were placed in the program by the Milwaukee Workforce Development Program. SDC Food Service Manager Earl Guyton noted the young workers provided a valuable service that positively impacted thousands of people.
