- Regular energy assistance to help with your annual home energy costs.
- Crisis assistance includes: retention of utility services, reconnections, oil deliveries and furnace repair or replacement. (Note: furnace repair or replacement is only available when home is owner occupied). It is offered when funds are available.
- Referrals for other heating related services.



It is intended to help pay a portion of heating costs and is not intended to pay the total annual heating cost. The amount of heating assistance benefit varies according to household size, income level, and household heating costs.



If you experience a loss of heat after hours please call 211.

Applicants must bring:

- Photo ID for the person who is completing an application.
- Proof of all income sources of your entire household's gross income for the 3 months prior to the month of application (i.e. child support, wages, pension, etc.) Seasonal employees will require the prior year's entire tax package.
- Social Security cards for everyone in the household
- Current energy bill (gas/electric/oil)
- If your heat is included with your rent you must provide a rent certificate or statement from the landlord confirming your heat is included with rent.

Please note that sites can process a limited number of applications each day. Day time visits are on a first-come-first-served basis. Evening appointments can be scheduled on SDC's website, weekdays Oct. 3 - Nov. 22 and Mar. 26 - May 15. Saturday appointments are available all season until May 12th. To qualify for an appointment you must be a full-time, first shift worker or a full-time day student. To receive an appointment there must be no other able-bodied person in the household who is at least 18 years of age.
