As we send this out, Governor Tony Evers is speaking at a statewide news conference in which he extended the Safer at Home order until May 26th. The order, that was set to expire next week, has significant impact. For example, public and private K-12 schools will remain closed for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year.
