Planning

SDC Grant Writer Barbara McKillop presented briefing papers BP2635-BP2639

Committee Chair, Nikki Purvis asked if SDC will be the Contractor or will they be subcontracting on BP2637. Ms. McKillop responded that SDC would employ a full-time person to give technical support to the contractor and administer small business mini grants for equipment purchases.

Ms. McKillop reported that she had attended the Home for Everyone Conference. She stated that it was spectacular and that she learned a lot. She said there were many conversations about Homeownership and affordable housing.

She reported that at the conference it they learned how predatory investors are acquiring properties and out pricing access and affordability

Ms. Purvis asked if this was an in-person conference opportunity. Ms. McKillop responded yes.

Ms. McKillop noted that SD Foundation BP2640 specifically requires that the opportunity be let through a 501 c 3.

SDC CEO, Dr. George Hinton said that the effort does sound like an initiative that fits SDC's engagement on the Research and Advocacy side of its over-all structure of the agency. He said empowering community to the extent that they understand they have the power to make a choice of how the re-design happens in their community is exciting.


